

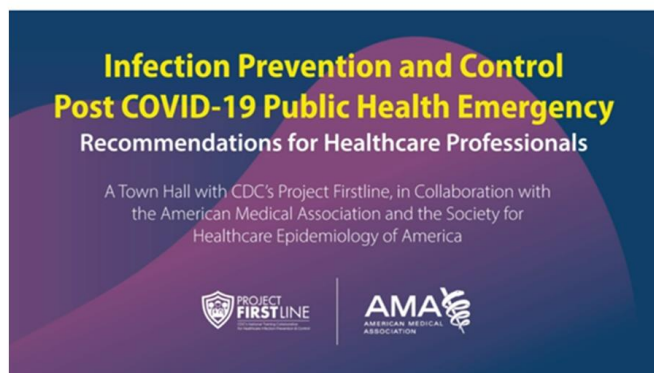


Georgia Project Firstline

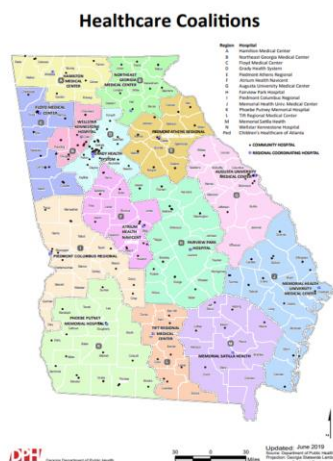
