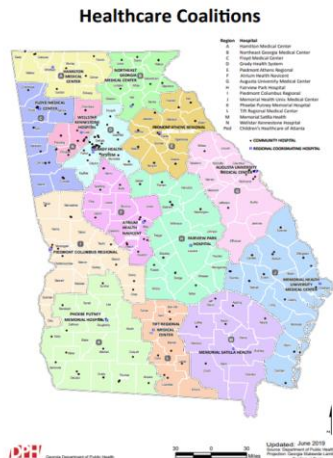




Georgia Project Firstline
