


Georgia Project Firstline

Could you have hepatitis B? The CDC recommends triple panel <u>hepatitis B screening</u> for auuts 18 years of age and older at least once during their lifetime. How can we prevent hepatitis B transmission? Vaccination is the best preventive action. Other health care-focused preventive actions include handwashing, PPE use, cleaning and disinfection, safe injection practices, and textile management.
