


Georgia Project Firstline

The Georgia Department of Public Health, in collaboration with the University of Georgia, is offering an opportunity for hospitals to receive respiratory program resource kits at no cost. The kits include respiratory fit testing supplies. The resource boxes were purchased with Nursing Home Strike Team funding. Because we have a surplus, we are able to offer the resource box to hospitals that provide a component of long-term or skilled nursing care to long-term care facility residents.

The resource boxes are being distributed by UGA and are available on a first come, first served basis. If your facility is interested, please send an email to <u>austin.dobbs@uga.edu</u>. Hospitals with more than 100 beds can request 2 (or more if supplies allow) boxes. All requests must be received no later than Feb. 29, 2024.
